

# BAKTOSSOL 225

Potassium and ammonium bisulphite

ANTISEPTIC - ANTIOXIDANT - ANTIOXIDASE

## CHARACTERISTICS

- Solution containing 225 g/L of SO<sub>2</sub>.
- **BAKTOSSOL 225** is a product for rinsing and storing wine related materials.
- **BAKTOSSOL 225** presents the characteristic SO<sub>2</sub> odour, and despite the fact that the odour is weak, it is preferable not to inhale it.
- **BAKTOSSOL 225** possesses the properties of SO<sub>2</sub> (see **BAKTOL P** data sheet). The solution is **ready-to-use**. Simply measure out the required volume.
- **BAKTOSSOL 225** is buffered to reduce SO<sub>2</sub> loss into the atmosphere, to facilitate its manipulation and to improve its storage over time, even in an opened canister.

## LEGISLATION

- ◆ The use of Ammonium Bisulphite is authorised on musts and partially fermented musts by the Community Regulation n° 1493/99.

## DOSAGE

- ◆ This product can also be used on musts or partially fermented musts in accordance with the above regulation.
- ◆ Dosages are extremely variable according to circumstances and usage periods. It is preferable to **follow the advice of an oenologist**.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- ◆ Measure the required quantity in a graduated test-tube or any other graduated container.
- ◆ Introduce into the volume to be treated and homogenise.
- ◆ On contact with colouring matter, the SO<sub>2</sub> instantly discolours it. This discolouration is reversible. As soon as the free SO<sub>2</sub> has disappeared, all the colouring matter reappears.

## PACKAGING

- ◆ 5L canister
- ◆ 10L jerrican

## STORAGE CONDITIONS

- ◆ Full sealed packaging in perfect condition, away from light in a dry, odourless place, **at a temperature superior to 5°C**.
- ◆ Opened packaging: to be used rapidly.

## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- ◆ **BAKTOSSOL 225 is classified as Xi-irritant :**
  - R31** : Contact with acids liberates toxic gas.
  - R36/37** : Irritating to eyes and respiratory system.
  - S26** : In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.
